Louisiana Supreme Court Justice John Weimer administered the oath of office to Thibodaux attorney Thad Toups today swearing-in Toups as president of the Louisiana Association of Drug Court Professionals (LADCP). Toups has been an integral member of the drug court team in Lafourche Parish for many years. LADCP is a statewide organization which partners with the Louisiana Supreme Court's Drug Court Office to provide training opportunities to Louisiana Drug Court Professionals and to promote and encourage the use of best practices in drug courts,

"In addition to being a respected Assistant District Attorney in Lafourche Parish, Thad Toups is recognized nationally and locally as a leader in substance abuse education, prevention and treatment. In 2011 he received the National DWI Court Leadership Award from the National Association of Drug Court Professionals and he is a founding member of the LADCP," Weimer said.

Toups received his undergraduate degree from Nicholls State University in 1973 and his law degree from LSU Law School in 1976. He has served over 32 years as an Assistant District Attorney for Lafourche Parish and the 17th Judicial District, having prosecuted one fourth of all criminal cases in Lafourche Parish from 1983–2000. Additionally, Toups headed the drug education and prevention programs of the District Attorney's Office including: the Drug Court Treatment Division and the Domino Effect Program, an instructional program on alcohol and drug abuse for high school seniors.

According to Justice Weimer, Louisiana's drug courts are also a true point of pride. There are currently 50 drug court programs in 42 parishes which operate under the auspices of the Louisiana Supreme Court, with 40 programs in operation for 10 years or longer. The benefits of this alternative to incarceration includes a reduction in crime and recidivism, as well as being cost-effective — every \$1.00 invested in drug court programs returns an average of \$3.36 in benefits of avoided justice system costs.

"The 30 adult drug courts, 17 juvenile drug courts and 3 family preservation drug courts keep Louisiana judges busy," Weimer added, "as judges preside over these courts in addition to their regular dockets with no additional compensation." More than 11,500 clients have graduated from the Louisiana drug court program since its inception in 2001.

Moral Reconciliation Therapy Training, a Manualized Evidence Based Protocol, will be offered to Louisiana Drug Courts at no cost for attendance.

Moral Reconciliation Therapy, MRT, will be offered to drug courts in Louisiana due to a partnership with the Office of Behavioral Health, the Supreme Court Drug Court Office and the Louisiana Association of Drug Court Professionals. The training is 3.5 days and will be offered in both the north and south of the state. Dates are tentatively set for August and September, but could change. Teams are urged to send their judge, coordinator, treatment personnel, case manager and probation officer. CEU's will be applied for. MRT is the premiere cognitive-behavioral curriculum for treating substance abuse and criminal justice offenders and is one of only a handful of offender treatment programs listed on SAMHSA's National Registry of Evidence-based Programs and Practices (NREPP).

With over 200 published outcome studies, **evidence-based** MRT has been shown to **significantly decrease recidivism**, increase moral reasoning, decrease program dropout rates, increase life purpose, and reduce antisocial thinking and behavior. **Increased sobriety** is accomplished due to an increase in life purpose and a reduction of sensation seeking behavior.

As a **manualized, open-ended** curriculum, MRT allows facilitators to **maximize resources** with no client waiting lists.

MRT was initially developed as the cognitive-behavioral component in a prison-based therapeutic community and directly addresses the Antisocial Personality Disorder which research has consistently shown to be at the core of many offender populations. Because of its remarkable success, the program was implemented with general inmate populations, juvenile offenders, in probation and parole, community corrections, hospital outpatient programs, educational settings, and has been **widely used in drug courts**. As of 2015, **MRT is 50 States Strong** and has been implemented in 7 countries.

The MRT curriculum is conducted in weekly group sessions guided by an MRT trained facilitator. Prior to group sessions, clients prepare homework, to present, that is passed or redone based on objective criteria.

All MRT facilitators must complete a 3.5 day intensive training that includes four additional hours of homework. During the hands on training, attendees will participate in group discussion, intensive lecture and small group participation. Each participant will receive a copy of: *How To Escape Your Prison* (the MRT workbook), the *MRT Facilitator's Handbook* (information on the group process, specific objective criteria and guidelines for all exercises with specific "how to" instructions), reprints of journal articles with outcome data on MRT

programs, *Effective Counseling Approaches* (a description of cognitive behavioral approaches, cognitive restructuring, and cognitive skills programs) A *5-Minute Stress Manager* CD, an *Imaginary Future* CD (used in training facilitators to help clients set appropriate long-term goals), *Antisocial Personality Disorder and Criminal Justice: Evidence-Based Practices* (information on treating the most resistant clients), and *Simply Spiritual* (an aid to understanding client belief systems).

CCI is the sole source provider of MRT training and materials and will train and certify facilitators to utilize the cognitive restructuring method of Moral Reconciliation Therapy™ (MRT). At the completion of training, participants will receive a certificate of completion and will be authorized to facilitate MRT groups. CEUs are available through Louisiana State University, Shreveport.

CCI offers a variety of curricula that can be used to supplement MRT or used alone for client needs such as, anger management, relapse prevention, trauma, domestic violence, job readiness, parenting, driving offenses, smoking cessation, criminal thinking, shoplifting, codependency and other client specific challenges.

Also offered, are a number of supportive materials such as, advanced training, basic review training, client journals, Coins for Step 3 completion and graduation, and audio resources. CCI Clinical Staff are available to answer questions and offer guidance through email or by telephone.
